ALL-TERRAIN and UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTE ORDINANCE TOWN OF SARATOGA, WOOD COUNTY

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING ALL-TERRAIN AND/OR UTILITY VEHICLE ROUTE(S) AND REGULATION OF THE OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN AND/OR VEHICLES AND UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLES

The Town Board of the Town of Saratoga, Wood County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section I --Intent

Adopt the following All-Terrain and/or Utility Terrain vehicle ordinance and route for the operation of All-Terrain and/or Utility Terrain vehicles upon the roadways listed in Section III.

Following due consideration of the recreational value to connect trail opportunities and weighted against possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, terrain involved, traffic density and history of automobile traffic, this route(s) has been created.

Section II-Statutory Authority

This ordinance is adopted as authorized under Wis. Statute 23.33(8)(b) STATE ALL-TERRAIN and/or Utility Terrain VEHICLES LAWS ADOPTED. The provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to all-terrain and/or utility terrain vehicles in the following enumerated Subsections of Sec. 23.33, Wis. Statutes and any future amendments or revisions, are hereby adopted by reference and made part of this Section as if fully set forth herein. Any acts required to be performed by the following Statutory Subsections or which are prohibited by such Statutory Subsections are required to be performed by this Section or are prohibited by this Section:

Section III--Designated Roadways and/or Highways

The following roads are designated as authorized All-Terrain and/or Utility Terrain Routes:

- (a) Church Avenue from Highway 73 to County Trunk U
- (b) 28th Street from Church Avenue to Ranger Road
- (c) 36^{th} Street from Church Avenue to Ranger Road
- (d) Hamann Avenue
- (e) Tower Road from 64th Street to County Trunk U

- (f) 64th Street South from Townline Road to Tower Road
- (g) Evergreen Avenue from County Trunk U to Highway 13
- (h) Tower Road from 64th Street South to Bell Road
- (i) Bell Road from Tower Road to Adams Avenue
- (i) Adams Avenue from Bell Road to 10th Avenue, Town of Rome
- (k) Ranger Road from North Hollywood to Highway 13
- (1) Ranger Road from Highway 13 to $52^{\rm nd}$ Street
- (m) North Hollywood Road from Ranger Road to County Trunk Z
- (n) Hillcrest Avenue from County Trunk Z to Range Line Road
- (o) Range Line Road from Highway 73 to Ten Mile Avenue
- (p) Bornbach Road
- (q) Young Street from Hwy 73 to Majestic Trail
- (r) Lexus Lane
- (s) Maria Drive
- (t) Ten Mile Avenue from Range Line Road to Bell Road
- (u) Private Trail from Ten Mile Avenue to Adams Avenue
- (v) Adams Avenue from Private Trail to 14th Avenue, Town of Rome
- (w) 16th Street 10 MPH speed limit
- (x) Blue Ridge Lane from Highway 13 to Love Road
- (y) Oak Street from Hwy 73 to County Trunk U

Section IV--Conditions

As a condition for the use of this route, the following conditions shall apply to all operators (and passengers). You must operate at the extreme right side of the paved roadway surface.

Section V--Enforcement

This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer.

Section VI-Penalties

Wisconsin State All-Terrain and/or Utility Terrain Vehicle penalties as found in S.23.33(13) (a) Wis. Statutes are adopted by reference.

Section VII-Severability

The provision of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

Section VIII-Revocation of Previous Ordinances

Town of Saratoga Ordinances 8-19-15 and 5-4-16 shall be revoked upon the passage of this Ordinance.

Section VII-Effective Date

This ordinance will become effective upon passage and publication.
