The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. Forbes was absent. The meeting was officially noticed.

Passineau made a motion to approve the January 6, 7, and 14th, 2015 meeting minutes. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Kerry Walters applied for a new business permit for KAW Furniture Promotions at 7830 Hwy 13 South. He is leasing the building. He has had the storage container removed and had the fire inspector at the building. The Fire Chief questioned the emergency and exit lighting in the addition. The building inspector will check the lighting. Passineau made a motion to grant the business permit for the original structure. There should be no public access to the addition until it is code compliant. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Lisa Havel gave the EMS report. They are having a fundraiser at the Town Hall on March 21, 2015.

1st Call Explosive Solutions have stored magazines in storage containers at 9051 St Hwy 13 S. A letter will be sent requesting their presence at a board meeting to get more information and letting them know that the use of storage containers are against Town Ordinance.

Frank made a motion to adopt resolution 1-21-15; Resolution Amending the Fee Schedule. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Lorelei Fuehrer gave the Building Inspector's report. The owner of PIRCO would like to remodel the basement of the community building on the property. He would like to have people use it as temporary housing. The community building is the Storm Shelter for the park. If the basement was turned into housing it would become a residential house at that point. The Board does not want the basement turned into an apartment.

Billie Jo gave the Treasurer's report. Choose to Re-Use is scheduled for May 30th at the Town Hall.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. Leo Piatz, 10720 Hwy 13 still has a few vehicles on the property. Dean Folts has a lot of vehicles on the property. His case had turned over to court. Dean Ramsden has hired an attorney to fight the process of the getting the ticket, not the agreement that he signed with the Town. Trial is set for January 28th.
