The Saratoga EMS would like to use the Town hall for Extrication training for June 27, 2015. Frank made a motion to allow them to use it at no charge. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

The Board discussed the County assessing property values versus the Town assessing. It is part of the State budget that the County would do the assessing. It would cost each resident significantly more to have the County do the assessing. Frank made a motion to approve Resolution 4-4-15; Resolution Opposing County Assessment Proposal in the State Budget Bill. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Billie Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. David Ramsden's court was cancelled, but he pay a \$124 fine. Erdman on Young Street will be looked at in the spring for clean-up.

The Pavloski's would like the Board to look at a resolution that would allow them dredge and use chemicals at NEPCO Lake. The Board would like the results from a Milfoil study that the Pavloski's had discussed at a previous meeting that they were going to do. They would also like to know what chemicals they would like to use.

Correspondence was read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
