The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Frank made a motion to accept the minutes for October 19, 2011. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed. Frank made a motion to accept the minutes for October 26, 2011. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Jennifer Ross, 6420 64th St., requested a new business license for Massage and Wellness, LLC. She would like to do business from her home. Passineau made a motion to grant the license. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Jesse Scheid, 8141 28th St S, requested a new business license for selling used tires at his property. He has gotten rid of all semi-trailers that he was using for storage. He has also gotten rid of all junk and unlicensed cars. The Constable stated that he is in compliance without ordinances. He does have 3 large vinyl structures. Lorelei Fuehrer gave the Building Inspector's report. She has issued 17 permits for the month of October.

Correspondence were read.

Heeg made a motion to pay the bills. Passeineau seconded it. Motion passed.
