The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Attorney Ken Hill has been contacted by Dan Fara regarding a fire bill that he is responsible for paying. He wanted to know if the board could hold the minutes open until further review. The board stated that they had made their decision about the responsibility of the bill already.

Frank made a motion to accept the minutes as written for August 3, 2011. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Roy and Colleen Ferkey were present. They would like to be able to put a model Pittsville home on Shawn Lewis's property on Hwy 13 across from Misty's Menu. The home would be on the property for one to two months. Passineau made a motion to allow the home on the property until November 1, 2011. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. Dennis Trickle paid his ticket, but still has a mess on his property. Another ticket will be sent along with a letter that tells him to get a clean-up plan to the board. Dan Billington and Dave Ramsden cases will be in Municipal Court on August 24th.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report. Four fire charge refund checks have been returned to the Town undeliverable without forwarding addresses. The Town will hold the checks for the 90 days and then they will be voided for Chris Garcia, Laura Wagner, Brooke Wilkins and Scott Bandle. Nikki DuBois, who owns several mobile home parks in the Town, was refunded two garbage and recycling fees that were collected on her taxes from the 2009 tax bill. She said that she was charged the fee for the years before that and would like the 5 years fees before that refunded. She did not notice it on her tax bills. The board only refunds the previous year if they are charged by mistake.

Correspondence was read.

Frank made a motion to pay the bills. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

The board did an audit of the Town books.

Heeg made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 8:45 p.m.
