The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:30 p.m. at the Town of Grand Rapids Municipal Building. Grand Rapids Chairman Don Bohn called the meeting to order. Frank was absent. The meeting was officially noticed.

Joe Terry from the Village of Port Edwards and Don Bohn and Arne Nystrom from the Town of Grand Rapids were present at the meeting.

The members of the municipalities discussed the upcoming Townline Road project. The municipalities were awarded a grant that will match what is spent up to \$863,212.17. The project would need to be paid for by the municipalities first and then would be reimbursed. Townline Road is a length of 4.5 miles. There are several intersections that will need to be addressed. The project needs to be finished by June 30, 2017. The Town of Grand Rapids and the Village of Port Edwards would be interested in reconstructing the road in 2013. Requests for Proposals for engineering will need to be sent out and then the municipalities will need to negotiate.

Arne Nystrom made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Doug Passineau seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
