CSM

Forbes said CSM 9095 by Badger Land Survey Inc., shows the road dedicated to the public. Dedicating the road to the public precludes any additional land transfers.

Canoe/Kayak Landing

Wipperfurth said the Wakely group will develop the signs and path to the landing to be known as "Point Basse Blue Water Landing." He also said the Wakely group will be relying on donations and existing funds, rather than applying for a grant for development. Discussion followed regarding the bridge weight limits. Forbes said he will meet with supplier of bridge mats to discuss the option of using mats to support the weight of trucks hauling gravel across the bridge.

Forbes said there is no action on the Nepco landing at this time, with possible improvements before winter. A site plan and parking lot design have been completed.

Information from Commission Members

Forbes said Heidi had been contacted by the North Central Regional Planning Commission about updating the Town Comprehensive Plan. Forbes suggested the Plan Commission upgrade the comprehensive plan by amending specific areas of the plan.

Snyder asked about a Trump campaign sign with offensive language. McDonald said the sign owner had painted out the offensive language.
