

TOWN OF SARATOGA
ORDINANCE TO REGULATE KEEPING AND DISPOSAL OF
GARBAGE AND RUBBISH

The Town Board, Town of Saratoga, Wood County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE AND RUBBISH

- 1.01 It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit, throw, or place any rubbish or garbage on or within any public street, road, alley, park, sidewalk, or other public place, except the Town Sanitary Landfill, or within or upon any private property or premises without the owner's consent.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS

- 2.01 'Garbage' shall mean and include all cans, bottles, crockery, glass, and all kinds of organic waste resulting from the preparation, use, cooking, handling, dealing in, or storing of meats, fish, fowl, or vegetables and all decayed or spoiled organic matter from any source whatever.
- 2.02 'Rubbish' shall mean and include ashes, paper, rags, garden refuse, grass clippings, or leaves, and all other items of a similar nature, but does not include trees, earth, concrete, or stones.

SECTION 3. PENALTY

- 3.01 Any person or persons who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance or fail to comply therewith, shall, upon conviction, be subject to a forfeiture of not more than \$200 and the costs of prosecution, and in default of immediate payment of such forfeiture and costs, such person or persons shall be committed to the County jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid, but not to exceed thirty (30) days. Each day a violation is in existence shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

- 4.01 This ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage and posting as provided by law.
