

TOWN OF SARATOGA BOARD MEETING MINUTES

This meeting was officially noticed on March 20th, 2025.

Chairman Fuehrer called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Motion (McDonald/Peterson) to go into closed session. Motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Fuehrer read the following: The board will go into closed session pursuant to Wis §19.85(1)(c) Considering employment, promotion, compensation, or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility. The purpose of this session is for the following: employee contract negotiations.

The Board reserves the right to come out of Closed Session and return into Open session authorized by Wis. §19.85(2): No Governmental body may commence a meeting, subsequently convene in closed session and thereafter reconvene again in open session within 12 hours after completion of the closed session, unless public notice of such subsequent open session was given at the same time and in the same manner as the public notice of meeting convened prior to the closed session. The Town Board may take action from the closed session and continue with the agenda.

Motion (Greeneway/Peterson) to come out of closed session. Motion carries unanimously.

Motion (Peterson/McDonald) to change the working schedule to 10 hours days from May 1 to September 30th. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion (McDonald/Peterson) to include sweatshirts in provided safety apparel in employee handbook. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion (Peterson/Greeneway) to issue \$250 for safety and equipment allowance on 1st pay period of year commencing on January 2026. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion (McDonald/Peterson) to change Employee Handbook from 3 days of sick time to 4 days. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion (McDonald/Greeneway) to adjourn. Motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 6:06 p.m.
