

Town of Saratoga's GUIDE TO RECYCLING

ITEMS THAT CAN BE INCLUDED IN YOUR RECYCLING:

Paper Products.....Special instructions

All Paper products should be placed in a paper bay or bundled

Acceptable

Newspaper & Inserts
Magazines & Soft Cover Books
Junk Mail & Envelopes
Phone Books & Catalogs
Office Paper (Any Color)
Corrugated Cardboard
Paper Grocery Bags
Non-Corrugated Cardboard

(Cereal, Soda, and Beer Boxes)

Container Products...Special instructions

All Acceptable Glass, Plastic, Aluminum, and Tin should be placed in a tote or cart

Acceptable

Glass: Clear, Brown or Green ONLY

Beverage & Food Container (Jugs & Jars)

Rinse out containers

It is not necessary to remove paper labels

Plastics: # 1 - # 7

Rinse out containers

It is not necessary to remove paper labels

Cans: Aluminum & Steel (or Bi-Metal) CANS ONLY

Rinse out containers

It is not necessary to remove paper labels

Place lids inside can and squeeze top to secure lids

Not Acceptable items (place in trash)

Tissue Products and Paper Toweling
Frozen Food Boxes
Dairy Carton Boxes
Paper Contaminated with Food Residue or Debris
Pizza Boxes or Carryout Food Wrappers

Not Acceptable Items(place in trash)

Aluminum Foil
Paint Cans (Non-Oil Based ONLY)
Aerosol Cans
Pesticide or Herbicide Containers
Styrofoam or Microwave Containers

Items that can be dropped off at the Transfer Site on County Rd Z

Tires (depending on the tire, there may be a charge)

Refrigerators Microwaves

Freezers Metal

Air Conditioners Car Batteries

Old Oil

Check ahead for hours and days of operation

All Construction or Building materials Will need to be taken to the landfill

Yard Waste

A ticket may be purchased at the Saratoga Mini Mart around Mid-April for the use of the Wisconsin Rapids Compost Site (Corner of Hwy 54 & Cty W). You are able to take compost out after you bring yard waste into the site.
